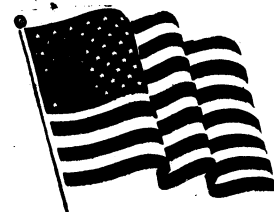
the workers can be at the hall by 1:30 at the latest so we can be ready to go. The signs say 2:30, but if there are people waiting we could start a little earlier.
